## Week 6 May 24 - Study day

• All year 12 students study day



### Week 7 May 27-31 - ATAR exam week

- All year 12 students studying general pathway attend all classes at school Monday to Thursday as normal.
  - General pathway students do not attend school on **Friday 31**st **May.**
- Year 12 students doing ATAR pathway attend school when then have exams.
  - All ATAR students will gather in the LRC before their exams and a form teacher will walk them across after a prayer and devotions.
  - If a year 12 ATAR student wishes to stay on campus to study before or after an exam they must sign in at secondary reception and study in the LRC.
  - If a student only has one or two ATAR exams as they are not studying the 'full ATAR pathway' they are to select a day to stay at home to study but attend all other days as normal.

## Copy of information on Exam timetable

#### **Information for ATAR students**

When ATAR students do not have exams, they may be either studying at home, or at school in room 3.16 (LRC)

They can also be working with a teacher (by appointment) at school.

If they are at school, they must sign in at Secondary reception.

When students have finished an exam, they must either leave the College signing out at Secondary reception or carry on with study in room 3.16.

## <u>Information for General pathway students</u>

Students studying the general pathway are expected to attend school as normal. Classes will continue with coursework and assignments. Year 12 general pathway students are however given two days off over this block.

Those being **Friday 24 May** and **Friday 31 May**.

If students attend TAFE or Work placement on any of these days they are to attend as normal.

## <u>Information for General pathway students with 1 or 2 ATAR exams</u>

Students studying the general pathway who do study 1 or 2 ATAR courses are expected to attend school as normal. However, they are permitted to have a study day on the day prior to their ATAR exam. Year 12 general pathway students are given two days off over this block. Those being **Friday 24 May** and **Friday 31 May** (unless they have an exam that day).

If students attend TAFE or Work placement on any of these days they are to attend as normal (unless they have an exam that day)..

<sup>•</sup> Students who are absent from any exam must notify the Deputy Principal - Teaching and Learning (Mr Marlow) immediately and provide a medical certificate. No allowance will be made for students who miss an exam due to reading the timetable incorrectly. Mr Marlow will then arrange a catch up exam time for the student.
